You **cannot** deduct the cost of food consumed by you, your family, or children who live in the home.

To use the Standard Meal & Snack Rate you don't need receipts for purchases. Calculate the days and hours that eligible children attended your day care using attendance records. Use attendance details to calculate how many meals and snacks were consumed.
