

CHANGES TO THE RENTER'S CREDIT

If you're a renter, there are some key changes to be aware of when you file your 2024 tax return. Please read through the following updates to ensure you're fully informed.

- **The Renters Credit is now part of your state return:** There is no longer a separate filing process for the Renters Credit. It's included directly in your state return (Form M1).

- **Bring all of your Certificate of Rent Paid forms (CRPs) when filing your taxes:** If you don't have them, you'll need to amend your state return later. This will significantly increase processing times.

- **There will be no separate refund issued during the summer:** You may be used to receiving this refund in the summer but that will no longer happen. Your renter's credit will be included as a part of your total state refund and will be processed shortly after filing your taxes.

Please note: These changes apply only to renters. Homeowners and mobile home owners will still need to use the M1PR form.
